Hand Foot and Mouth Disease

Unfortunately we have had a few cases of Hand Foot and Mouth Disease in school. This is a highly contagious disease.

The symptoms are:

- a sore throat
- a high temperature
- not wanting to eat
- mouth ulcers, which can be painful
- a raised rash of spots on the hands and feet, and sometimes the groin area and bottom
- The rash of spots can look pink, red, or darker than the surrounding skin, depending on your skin tone.



Hand, foot and mouth disease usually gets better on its own in 7 to 10 days. You cannot take antibiotics or other medicines to cure it.

To help the symptoms:

- drink cool fluids to soothe the mouth and prevent dehydration (but avoid acidic drinks, such as fruit juice)
- eat soft foods like yoghurt and avoid hot, salty and spicy foods
- take paracetamol or ibuprofen to help ease a sore mouth or throat

How to stop hand, foot and mouth disease spreading

Hand, foot and mouth disease is easily passed on to other people. It is spread in coughs, sneezes, poo and the fluid in the blisters. You can get it more than once.

You can start spreading it from a few days before you have any symptoms, but you're most likely to spread it to others in the first 5 days after symptoms start.

To reduce the risk of spreading hand, foot and mouth disease:

- wash your hands often with soap and water, and children's hands too
- use tissues to trap germs when you cough or sneeze
- bin used tissues as quickly as possible
- do not share towels or household items like cups or cutlery
- wash soiled bedding and clothing on a hot wash

If you suspect your child has hand foot and mouth disease please visit a pharmacist or Doctor for confirmation. So as to reduce the risk to others we ask that you keep your child at home for at least 5 days. Please advise us of any absences by telephone – 01594 822171. Thank you.

Please note that a penalty is issued to each parent for each child taken out of school. A Penalty Notice is a fine of £80 if paid within the first 21 days which increases to £160 if paid between 21 and 28 days. Thereafter, if the penalty remains unpaid this may lead to prosecution through the Magistrates' Court.
