Changes to School Security

The school site security has been reviewed and we have changed the mechanism on the gate at the top of the slope in the rear playground. You will now need to be let in and let out by a member of staff.

All gates at the rear of the school will be locked between 8.45 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. If you know that you will be bringing your child into school later than 8.45 a.m. or collecting before 3.00 p.m. please let office staff know so that they can be available to unlock the gate.

Attendance, Absence and Lateness

The last few weeks we have seen unusually high levels of lateness, we know and understand that is it an effort to get going some mornings, but lateness is disruptive for all and can cause distress and anxiety for the children and classes.

We ask that you make a big effort to arrive in school on time, ready to walk through the doors at 8.40 a.m. A chat with friends in the playground is a great way to start the day.

A reminder that children should be attending school every day on time if they are well enough to do so. If they are absent for any reason we ask that you contact the office by telephone to advise us of the reason for absence. An answerphone is available if the office is unmanned. Please do not email as these may not be checked until later in the day.

School starts at **8.40 am**. Gates are locked at **8.45 am**, all children and parents arriving after this time must report to reception so that children can be signed into school.



A few reminders

PE Kit – this should be shorts and t-shirt (house colours if possible) trainers/daps. Tracksuit bottoms and school jumpers can be worn on colder days.

Hair – long hair should be tied up whilst in school – girls and boys

Jewellery – we discourage jewellery in school, ear rings must be removed before PE sessions

Coats – a warm waterproof coat should be brought to school each day as we do like the children to go outside even on cold or drizzly days.

School Meals – should be paid for in advance of ordering. Menus should be returned on a Monday during registration time to ensure your meal of choice is ordered.



You may be issued with a penalty notice for taking your child out of school during term time. Please note that a penalty is issued to <u>each</u> parent for <u>each</u> child taken out of school. A Penalty Notice is a fine of £80 if paid within the first 21 days which increases to £160 if paid between 21 and 28 days. Thereafter, if the penalty remains unpaid this may lead to prosecution through the Magistrates' Court.
