As well as hot chocolate and biscuits we would like to ask for donations of any socks, during the wet months our spare socks pile has vanished.











Maple Class

School Meals

We have been advised that the cost of school meals will increase from 1st April 2025.

For children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 a school meal will cost £2.85

For children in Pre-School a school meal will cost £2.89

Children in reception, year 1 and year 2 are entitled to a free government funded universal infant free school meal (UIFSM).

If you are on a low income or in receipt of certain benefits you may be able to claim for free schools meals. This not only allows your child a free meal each day but also provides the school with additional funding to use on resources and support throughout the school.

You may be issued with a penalty notice for taking your child out of school during term time. Please note that a penalty is issued to <u>each</u> parent for <u>each</u> child taken out of school. A Penalty Notice is a fine of £80 if paid within the first 21 days which increases to £160 if paid between 21 and 28 days. Thereafter, if the penalty remains unpaid this may lead to prosecution through the Magistrates' Court.
