Please do not email as these may not be checked until later in the day.


Holly Leaves Class

Maple Class

We have been learning about The Battle of Britain in history as part of the unit: What impact did WW2 have on the people of Britain? As a group, we sorted a number of statements into a Venn diagram according to who had the advantage - the RAF or the Luftwaffe.

Did you know... German fighter pilots were well-trained and had more combat experience than RAF pilots?
