Attendance, Absence and Lateness

This week we have seen unusually high levels of lateness, we know and understand that is it dark, cold and an effort to get going in the mornings, but lateness is disruptive for all and can cause distress and anxiety for the children and classes.

We ask that you make a big effort to arrive in school on time, ready to walk through the doors at 8.40 a.m. A chat with friends in the playground is a great way to start the day.

A reminder that children should be attending school every day on time if they are well enough to do so. If they are absent for any reason we ask that you contact the office by telephone to advise us of the reason for absence. An answerphone is available if the office is unmanned. Please do not email as these may not be checked until later in the day.

School starts at **8.40 am**. Gates are locked at **8.45 am**, all children and parents arriving after this time must report to reception so that children can be signed into school.

It also gives you the time to fill in any paperwork and chat with staff about your child's needs and interests



Reminder we are NUT FREE School

A reminder that we are a nut free school due to two of our children being diagnosed with life threatening nut allergies.

Please do not send your child to school with items that contain nuts – for example:

- Peanut butter sandwiches
- Chocolate spread sandwiches
- Cereal bars
- Some granola bars
- Cakes that contain nuts
- Biscuits / Cookies that contain nuts



We ask that you check labels of food to ensure that it is 'nut free'

We do acknowledge that many foods are labelled as 'may have been produced in a factory handling nuts and cannot be guaranteed to be nut free'. Such items will be allowed in school as it would be unreasonable to expect these to be kept out of school.

We thank you in advance for your co-operation and support regarding this matter.

Holiday Requests

You may be issued with a penalty notice for taking your child out of school during term time. Please note that a penalty is issued to <u>each</u> parent for <u>each</u> child taken out of school. A Penalty Notice is a fine of £80 if paid within the first 21 days which increases to £160 if paid between 21 and 28 days. Thereafter, if the penalty remains unpaid this may lead to prosecution through the Magistrates' Court.
